Atwater - Donnelly

Aubrey Atwater and Elwood Donnelly present an enthralling concert of traditional American and Celtic American folk songs, hymns, a cappella pieces, dance tunes, and original works. They blend unusual harmonies and play guitar, Appalachian mountain dulcimer, Irish tin whistle, harmonica, banjo, bones, spoons, limberjack, Australian monkey pods, toy xylophone, and other surprises.

Aubrey and Elwood explain song origins to give more relevance to the material, and they incorporate humor, audience participation, and a highly relaxed stage presence which makes their performances appealing to all ages.

Aubrey has been performing original songs of social commentary, as well as contemporary American folk songs and traditional ballads, since 1981.

Elwood has been performing professionally since the age of fifteen: first in a rock band, then as a solo performer, and later in a Cambodian band. He writes songs for voice, guitar, and harmonica.
