The *Folk Music Society of Huntington's* **FIRST SATURDAY CONCERTS** will present:

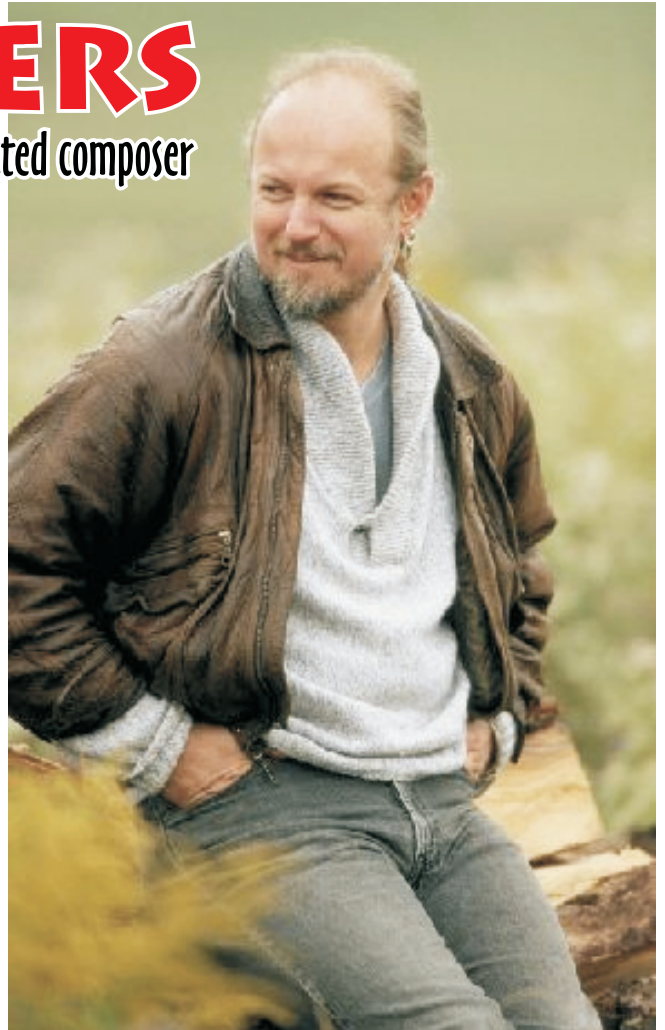
# **GARNET ROGERS**

*... a first-class interpreter, a profound lyricist, and a respected composer*

Garnet Rogers has established himself as one of the major talents of our time. Hailed as a charismatic performer and singer, Garnet is a man with a powerful physical presence—close to six and a half feet tall— with a voice to match. With his smooth, dark baritone, his incredible range, and thoughtful, dramatic phrasing, Garnet is widely considered by fans and critics alike to be one of the finest singers anywhere. His music, like the man himself, is literate, passionate, highly sensitive, and deeply purposeful. Cinematic in detail, his songs give expression to the unspoken vocabulary of the heart. An optimist at heart, Garnet sings extraordinary songs about people who are not obvious heroes and of the small victories of the everyday. As memorable as his songs, his over-the-top humor and lightning-quick wit moves his audience from tears to laughter and back again.

Since leaving high school, Garnet was on the road as a full-time working musician with his older brother, the legendary Stan Rogers. Together these native Canadians formed what has come to be accepted as one of the most influential acts in North American folk music.

Now on his own, Garnet Rogers is capable of awe-inspiring and unpredictable stuff — and that includes more than just music. Come see what that means.
