The resulting album, that *The New Yorker* dubbed "a collection of lovely harmonizing and pure emotion," was an astonishing success.

After achieving a doctorate in Psychology and raising a family, Lucy is now recording and performing full-time; Kaplansky's voice continues to remain in high demand

by her peers: Shawn Colvin, Suzanne Vega, John Gorka, Bill Morrissey, Cliff Eberhardt, and she records often with them.

The imagery and emotion of Lucy Kaplansky's original lyrics combine with the power and texture of her sumptuous voice to create an illuminating evening of songs that work their way deep into the heart. Fusing alternative country, roots rock, and folk music with rare style and intelligence — not to mention a truly charming stage presence — Lucy presents her thoughtful songs about the human condition with warmth and power.

Lucy has a collection of songs that explore love and the dark, winding road that leads us there. Her new life as a mother has not hindered her musical life but has enhanced it, deepening the emotional depth of her songwriting.
